Test Site Information

The testing will be inside an enclosed garage with concrete floor. Please note that the test site is in a residential neighborhood so it is important to keep your dogs' barking to a minimum. There will be two separate entry and exit doors to the main testing area. Two restrooms are located in the second floor of the test site and are available for use by ORT participants.

PARKING: Parking is not available within the testing site. However you may park your car on the street, including on Akule Street or Aweoweo Street. You may drop your crates off at the test site first, and then go and park your car.

CRATING: Please bring dog crates/pens and any other comfort requirements (bedding, shade, water bowls, etc.) so that your dog can be comfortable in the outdoor crating area. Shaded car parking areas will not be available at the test site. Indoor crating areas and shaded outdoor areas may be limited so please plan to bring your own tent, Aluminet shade and/or crate fans to keep your dog(s) cool. You may also want to bring a comfortable chair for waiting outdoors.

POTTING: The yard and street areas may be used for pottying your dogs. You are responsible for picking up after your dog. There will be a trash can near the front gate for depositing dog waste.

LUNCH: Please bring your own lunch and drinks as needed. Restaurants are within 4 miles of the facility in Haleiwa town.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A 6 FOOT LEASH AT ALL TIMES when not being tested. No flexi-leashes for walking dogs on test site grounds; flexis may be used in the test itself.

Entry Requirements

The handler of the dog must be a current member of the NACSW™. The Dog must be registered with the NACSW™. For information on how to register or become a member go to www.NACSW.net

Entry Fee and Second Dog Policy

\$25.00 per dog per odor. One dog per odor per handler maximum.

Closing Date

Entries and payment must be received at the Secretary's address by February 13th, 2015 at 5:00 pm. Overnight mail entries must have the signature request waived.

Refund Policy

Cancellations made on or before February 13th, 2015 by 5:00pm will be refunded minus a \$10 administration fee. No refunds after the entry closing date. Cancellations may be made by e-mail to kyoko@countrycaninehawaii.com. The secretary is not responsible for lost e-mails or calls that do not reach her. The secretary will send an e-mail back to the participant confirming the cancellation.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the NACSW™ official or judge.

Video/Photography Policy

ORT participants are allowed to have a friend or family member video/photograph their test. ORT participants are not allowed to video/photograph one another. ORT hosts are not obligated to provide someone to video/photograph.

Directions to Test Site

* Take H-2 North freeway to the end until it turns into a regular road (Wiilikina Drive). You will pass Schofield Barracks military base on your left.

* Veer left at the fork towards WAIALUA (not right towards North Shore). Stay on this road (Kaukonahua Rd) for several miles. It will turn into a windy road going downhill.

* At the bottom of the hill, you will pass a flashing yellow light, then a few stores and a service station on your left.

* At the fork, veer RIGHT towards WAIALUA, and go straight down GOODALE AVENUE.

* Turn LEFT at the Stop sign (at Waialua Library and Aloha gas station).

- * Take an immediate RIGHT and continue on GOODALE AVENUE, which will take you around a baseball field / district park.
- * Turn LEFT at the T-intersection/Stop sign onto WAIALUA BEACH RD and drive 1.2 miles.
- * Turn RIGHT on AWEOWEO ST (there will be no street sign, but you will see Waiialua Christian Church on your right).
- * Take your second RIGHT onto AKULE ST.
- * Arrive at 68-084 AKULE ST, which will be 3 houses down on the mauka side.

THE TEST SITE will be open from **8:00am**.

HANDLER BRIEFING: 8:45am

Score books are optional and are not required to participate in an ORT. They are for personal record keeping. If you have lost a scorebook and would like a replacement, you can request a replacement book that will include all your prior NACSW results. Log in to your account at: <http://www.nacsw.net> and under the "My Account" section, go to "My Dogs" and choose the option to order a replacement score book there.

NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE SEARCH AREA during the ORT except NACSW™ officials, adults accompanying a minor, CNWI-in-training, or immediate family members/friends of the dog/handler team currently being tested.

ENTRIES:

- TELEPHONE, FAX, UNSIGNED ENTRIES, AND ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES cannot be accepted.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
- ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON THE ATTACHED ENTRY FORM.
- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- OWNERS are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.
- EXPRESS MAIL entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Participants are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready when it is to be judged. Be prepared to keep your dog in your crate when not being tested or on leash at all times. There is no inside crating at this test.

FEMALES IN SEASON – Contact your test host if your dog comes into season. Bitches in heat will be placed last in the running order. MUST wear britches and must potty in designated areas.

DOGS PARTICIPATING in ORT must be at least six months of age and must appear to be healthy on trial day and should be current on all vaccinations required by law.

Acknowledgement of entry acceptance/CONFIRMATION will be made when entries are processed for those handlers that provide an email address. If you require a confirmation via USPS, you must provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry.

BASIC DESCRIPTION OF TEST – To successfully pass an ORT a dog must identify the location of the target odor and the handler must correctly call an "alert" within a three-minute time period. The Odor Recognition Test consists of a drill type exercise which requires 12 closed boxes set up in a pattern of one or two rows, spaced a minimum of 48" apart. The ORT is conducted on leash. Complete information can be obtained on the NACSW™ website.
