### Test Site Information

The testing will be inside a gymnasium with wood floors. There will be two separate entry and exit doors to the main testing area. One restroom is located in the ORT area and may NOT be used during testing; however, a restroom is available at all times at McDonald's diagonally across the street on Kamehameha Highway.

**PARKING:** There is a large parking lot at the testing site. Shaded parking spots are limited.

**CRATING:** Please bring dog crates/pens and any other comfort requirements (bedding, shade, water bowls, etc.) so that your dog can be comfortable in the outdoor crating area. Indoor crating areas will not be available. Shaded and covered outdoor areas may be limited so please plan to bring your own tent, Aluminet shade and/or crate fans to keep your dog(s) cool and dry. You may also want to bring a comfortable chair for waiting outdoors.

**POTTYING:** The grassy areas surrounding the parking lot may be used for pottying your dogs. You are responsible for picking up after your dog. Please dispose of waste in outdoor trash cans on site, or take them out with you.

**MEALS:** Please bring your own meals and drinks as needed. Restaurants are within walking distance of the testing site.

**ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A 6 FOOT LEASH AT ALL TIMES** when not in the car/crate and not being tested. No flexi-leashes for walking dogs on test site grounds; flexis may be used in the test itself.

### Entry Requirements

The handler of the dog must be a current member of the NACSW™. The Dog must be registered with the NACSW™. For information on how to register or become a member go to [www.NACSW.net](http://www.NACSW.net)

### Trial Eligibility and ORTs

*An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening date to be eligible for the first draw period.*

### Entry Fee and Second Dog Policy

\$25 per dog per odor. \$20.00 for second dog per odor. Two dogs maximum per handler. Please fill out a separate registration form for each dog to be tested.

### Closing Date

August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016

Overnight mail entries must have the signature request waived.

### Refund Policy

Cancellations made on or before August 20<sup>th</sup> 2016 by 5:00pm will be refunded minus a \$10 administration fee. No refunds after the entry closing date. Cancellations may be made by e-mail to [kyoko@countrycaninehawaii.com](mailto:kyoko@countrycaninehawaii.com). The secretary is not responsible for lost e-mails or calls that do not reach her. The secretary will send an e-mail back to the participant confirming the cancellation.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the NACSW™ official or judge.

### Video/Photography Policy

ORT participants are allowed to have a friend or family member video/photograph their test. ORT participants are not allowed to video/photograph one another. ORT hosts are not obligated to provide someone to video/photograph.

### Directions to Test Site

- \* Take H-2 North freeway.
- \* Take exit 8 towards Wahiawa.
- \* Merge onto HI-99/Kamehameha Highway and continue to follow Kamehameha Highway through Wahiawa and past the pineapple fields.
- \* At the bottom of the hill, turn left into HALEIWA town.
- \* Merge into the traffic circle and take the first exit towards Haleiwa.
- \* Waiialua Community Association will be on your right soon after passing McDonald's on your left.

## **TEST Information**

**THE TEST SITE** will be open from **3:30pm**.

**CHECK-IN: 3:45-4:15pm**

**HANDLER BRIEFING: 4:15pm**

**An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening date to be eligible for the first draw period.**

**Score books are optional and are not required to participate in an ORT.** They are for personal record keeping. If you have lost a scorebook or would like a replacement, you can request a replacement score book that will include all your prior NACSW results. Log in to your account at: <http://www.nacsw.net> and under the "My Account" section, go to "My Dogs" and choose the option to order a replacement score book there. The cost is \$20.

**NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE SEARCH AREA** during the ORT except NACSW™ officials, adults accompanying a minor, CNWI-in-training, or immediate family members/friends of the dog/handler team currently being tested.

### **ENTRIES:**

- TELEPHONE, FAX, UNSIGNED ENTRIES, AND ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES cannot be accepted.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
- ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON THE ATTACHED ENTRY FORM.
- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- OWNERS are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.
- EXPRESS MAIL entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

**DOGS PRESENT** will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged. Be prepared to keep your dog in your car when not being tested or on leash at all times. There is no inside crating at this test.

**FEMALES IN SEASON – Contact your test host at least 1 day before the ORT if this becomes a possibility.**

**DOGS PARTICIPATING** in ORT must be at least six months of age and must appear to be healthy on trial day and should be current on all vaccinations required by law.

**Acknowledgement of entry acceptance/CONFIRMATION** will be made when entries are processed for those handlers that provide an email address. If you require a confirmation via USPS, you must provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry.

**BASIC DESCRIPTION OF TEST** – to successfully pass an ORT a dog must identify the location of the target odor and the handler must correctly call an "alert" within a three-minute time period. The Odor Recognition Test consists of a drill type exercise which requires 12 closed boxes set up in a pattern of one or two rows, spaced a minimum of 48" apart. The ORT is conducted on leash. Complete information can be obtained on the NACSW™ website.
